




We are really looking forward to seeing our superstar pupils in action and we are sure you are too!


We love to learn!

Literacy

We will work on completing our class novel, 'The Iron Man' and take part in exciting activities linked to the book, such as creating a menu for the Iron Man. We'll have a go at writing our **own** version of Chapter Four.

We'll be learning about onomatopoeia, as well as beginning to explore how the apostrophe is used in contractions. We'll continue to work on our joined writing and will really work hard on those diagonal and horizontal joins! In our phonics, we'll learn ways of spelling the **r sound** (r, rr, wr, rh) and **l sound** (l, al, il, le, ol, ll, el).



The World Around Us

Continuing our topic of **Mighty Me**, our main focus this month will be on **body** organs. We'll learn to name, locate and describe the job that these organs do:

brain lungs liver heart stomach kidney small intestine large intestine



Numeracy

We'll be working on **mental strategies** for addition, subtraction and multiplication this month. We will work hard to:

- consolidate our understanding of the relationship between + and -;
- use known number facts and place value to add or subtract mentally, including any pair of two-digit whole numbers;
- choose and use appropriate number operations and appropriate ways of calculating (mental, mental with jottings, pencil and paper) to solve problems; and
- develop strategies for multiplying beyond the tables.

Don't forget to keep working on quick and accurate recall of all multiplication and division facts for the 2 - 12 times tables!
