Schedule

Every night (Monday – Thursday), children will have:

- Reading
- Learning homework: spellings and tables
- Mental Maths
- A written task (usually literacy or numeracy based)

Children will also receive library books (from our school and classroom collections). They will be notified of the day on which to return these.

Please note that it will take us a few weeks to fully establish this homework schedule. Tasks will be introduced gradually over the course of the month.

All tasks are due the next day, unless otherwise stated.

There may be nights when other tasks are set; these may be in addition to, or as replacements for, tasks on our regular schedule. Children may also receive the privilege of having a night off some (or even all) of their homework!

Signing

We ask that **every book / piece** of homework is signed by an adult **every night**.

If appropriate, you may wish to add a comment on how your child has managed the task. However, please note that this is not expected in all tasks!



What to do if you have a query

If your child has a problem completing his / her homework, or you have any questions, please write a note in the Homework Diary, or make arrangements to see the class teacher. We will do all that we can to resolve the problem.
