Learning Plan

Year Five's

Literacy

- We will be learning about **adverbs** and **suffixes**.
- We will complete our class novel, Fantastic Mr. Fox.
- We will enjoy exploring the language in a selection of **poetry**, and will get a chance to write our own poems.
- We will grow in our knowledge and understanding of the features and purposes of **instructional texts**.
- In our phonics work, we will be exploring ways that we can write the ee, ay and oo sounds.
- We'll be continuing with our joined handwriting, with a special focus **diagonal joins**.

Topic

We'll be continuing our learning about Ancient Egypt. This month, we will be exploring the topic of farming. We will also find out about the process of mummification and the importance of the afterlife to the Ancient Egyptians. We'll get to learn about Egyptian gods, goddesses, and pharaohs too.

Numeracy

In Numeracy this month, we will be:

revising multiplication and division by 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10.

We will also be focusing on **money**, **2D shape** and **length**.

Within the topic of **money**, we will be:

- counting out money amounts using £20, £10 and £5 notes and all coins;
- converting from pounds and pence to pence and vice versa, with 4-digit amounts;
- rounding to the nearest pound.

Learning about **2D shape**, we will be:

- recognising and describing a variety of 2D shapes;
- using shapes to continue and create patterns.

Exploring the topic of **length**, we will be:

- revising measuring in m and cm;
- recording lengths in different forms,
 e.g. 1m 36cm→136cm→1.36m;
- measuring and drawing lengths to the nearest half-centimetre;
- learning about perimeter.
