OUR LEARNING PLAN

Year Five: January, 2017



Literacy

In our writing activities, we will be looking at **similes** and **adjectives**.

We will complete an exciting unit of work on **Fantasy Stories**. During this unit, we will read passages from stories which include strange characters living in the real world. We will find out how the author creates tension and explore the relationship between the character and the setting. We will analyse aspects of writing a fantasy story, before we plan and write our very own fantasy story.

We will begin our next class novel - '**The Iron Man**' by Ted Hughes. We will create a character sketch of the Iron Man, write a simile poem about the character and also create a 'Menu for the Iron Man'!

We'll continue to work on our phonics, where we'll explore different ways of writing sounds. We'll complete more joined handwriting activities as well. A busy month!

Numeracy

In Numeracy this month, we are:

- completing our work on **fractions** (see December's newssheet for details);
- learning **multiplication** and **division** facts for the **7** and **9 times tables**;
- revising the sequence of **months** and the number of days in each month;
- **reading calendars** to identify the day, given the date, and vice-versa;
- extending calendar work to finding durations, in weeks or days, which 'bridge' consecutive months;
- learning how to **read the time in 5 minute intervals** on analogue and digital displays;
- **writing times in 5 minute intervals**, using 12-hour notation and am/pm;
- learning how to **read and write the time in 1 minute intervals** on analogue and digital displays using 12-hour notation and am/pm;
- beginning to explore **place value** for **4-digit numbers**.

Topic

- We'll be starting our new topic on '**Sound and hearing**'.
- We will be exploring three key areas:
 1. How is sound **created**?
 2. How do we **hear** sound?
 3. How is sound **measured**?
- We will also take part in an experiment about **muffling sound**.
- There'll be an opportunity for us to find out about the **history of telephones** and to learn about **Alexander Graham-Bell**.
