Literacy

We'll continue to work on our **phonics**, where we'll explore different ways of writing sounds. We'll complete more **joined handwriting** activities as well.


We'll also begin to learn about **prefixes**.

Numeracy

In Numeracy this month, we are:

- **revising multiplication** and **division** facts for all of the tables we have learned so far;
- learning **multiplication** facts for the **12 times tables**;
- continuing to explore **place value** for **4-digit numbers**;
- understanding what the **<** and **>** symbols mean;
- exploring mental strategies for the **addition of 3-digit numbers**;
- exploring mental strategies for **subtraction involving 3-digit numbers**; and
- continuing with our work in **mental mathematics** and **problem solving**.
